

Amendments to Board's Rules

- 3737-1-04(H) This rule increases the tank fee from \$500 to \$550 for the standard deductible.
- 3737-1-07(B) This was added to require that where eligibility applications are incomplete, the director shall ask for more information and if the tank owner does not timely respond to the request, eligibility shall be denied.
- 3737-1-08(B) This now provides that claims may be reviewed on a non first-come, first-serve basis when efficiency and cost savings will be realized and also provides that claims for "NFA'd" sites may be prioritized.
- 3737-1-09(13) This now provides a fifty percent reduction in reimbursement for costs not properly submitted for pre-approval (the previous reduction penalty was twenty percent (20%).
- 3737-1-12(C)(7) This was created to establish a "catch all" deadline for corrective action work that doesn't specifically fit within any defined tasks.
- 3737-1-12(D) This was added to create time frames for corrective action work performed under the new (2005) BUSTR rules.
- 3737-1-12(E) This was altered to reflect BUSTR requirements in which tank owners are mandated to perform work under the new (2005) BUSTR corrective action rules.
- 3737-1-12(F) This was created to address claim submission deadlines when tank owners receive extensions for completing corrective action from the fire marshal.
- 3737-1-12(G) This was created to address claim submission deadlines when the fire marshal issues a deficiency letter for program task(s).
- 3737-1-12(H) This was modified to reflect new reports that will be required under the new (2005) BUSTR rules.
- 3737-1-12.1(5) This was added to require an annual discussion of free product recovery effectiveness for those sites at which free product is an issue.
- 3737-1-19(A)(1) This was revised to make the language for applying for third party eligibility parallel to the first party eligibility language of 3737-1-07. Note that the same requirement has been added as in 3737-1-07(B) (incomplete applications must be timely responded to or eligibility will be lost).
